Bayou Land Conservancy raises funds at Washington Ave. bar for Deer Park Prairie

Located just minutes from downtown, Kung Fu Saloon is a popular spot for happy hour gatherings after work. The bar offers a relaxed atmosphere and features 17 vintage arcade games, shuffleboard and giant Jenga as well as free skeeball. Sustainable practices are woven into the building itself, as it is partially constructed with reclaimed 100 year old Texas barn wood. Events Coordinator Jessica Leblanc says the event “is just a way for Kung Fu Saloon to give back to our community.” The “Drink for a Cause” benefit for Bayou Land Conservancy is free and open to everyone ages 21+.

Bayou Land Conservancy is a nationally accredited land trust dedicated to permanently protecting land in the Houston region. The group currently holds 48 preserves that preserve over 10,000 acres of sensitive habitat. Bayou Land Conservancy’s 9 public preserves allow for hiking, biking, horseback riding, and nature-watching.
